## ORDINANCE NO. 2024 - OC

## ORDINANCE DECLARING FIFTEEN AIR PACKS AND FIFTEEN AIR CYLINDERS OBSOLETE OR UNFIT FOR USE BY THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG.

Whereas; for the health, safety, morals, and welfare of the citizens of Lewisburg, Ohio, it is necessary and appropriate to maintain a modern self-contained breathing apparatus for use by the Fire Department in the suppression and extinguishment of fires for the Village of Lewisburg;

And Whereas; the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of fifteen air packs and fifteen air cylinders which are no longer capable of certification or re-certification for use by the Fire Department, which are obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village in the Operations of the Fire Department;

And Whereas; it is not economical or safe to maintain these items and would not be in the best interest of the citizens of the Village of Lewisburg to keep the equipment.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LEWISBURG, PREBLE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Council herein finds pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 the Village of Lewisburg is the owner of fifteen air packs and fifteen air cylinders, which are obsolete, unneeded and no longer fit to be used by the Village in the Operations of the Fire Department and is therefore salvage property with a value of less than \$1,000.

**Section 2**. Council directs the Municipal Manager to dispose of said property by transferring same to the Miami Valley Career Technology Center.

**Section 3.** Council directs the Municipal Manager to execute any documents necessary to effectuate transfer of ownership of said equipment to the purchaser, or to effectuate transfer of ownership as salvage.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be effective at the earliest time permitted by law.
